Incorrect. Use the power property ($a \cdot \log M = \log M^a$), the product property ($\log MN = \log M + \log N$), and the quotient property ($\log \left(\frac{M}{N}\right) = \log M - \log N$), to combine logarithms. Once you have $\log M = \log x$, you can then say that M = x.
