

Incorrect. First, triangles can be classified according to their sides: scalene (no congruent sides), isosceles (two congruent sides), or equilateral (three congruent sides). Second, triangles can be classified according to their angles: acute (all three angles less than 90°), right (contains a 90° angle), or obtuse (contains an angle that is greater than 90° and less than 180°).
